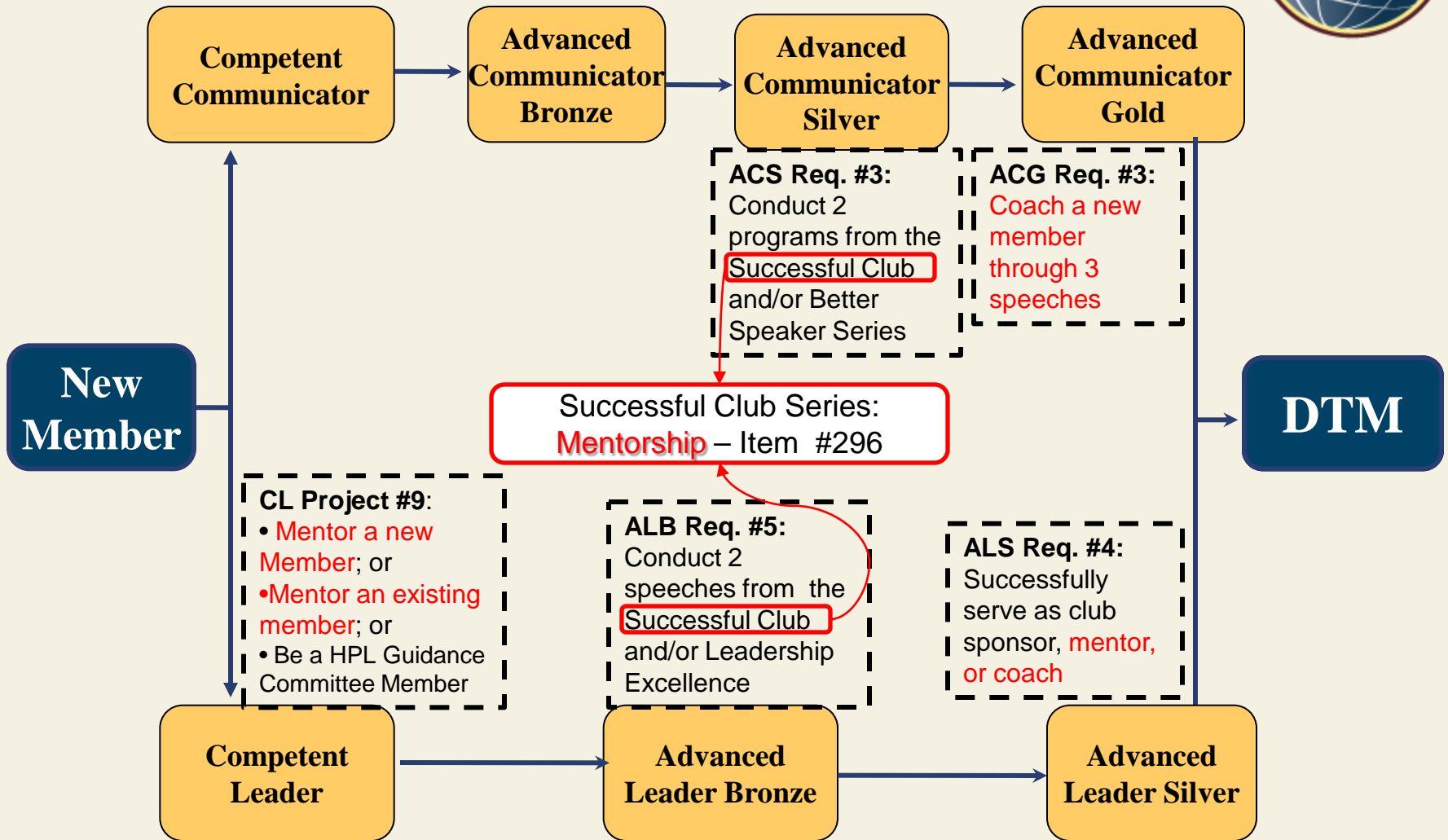

Pre-identify mentors/mentee  
pairs - a mix of experienced  
& new member mentorships.

presentation, and table  
topics.

Leverage the launch to

pairs. Ensure you understand  
how to best pair people.

Ensure all your tools are in
