- ▶ Up to 2 mentors per club.



Who Can Be A Mentor?

Any individual Toastmaster who is:

- ▶ Knowledgeable
- ▶ Helpful
- ▶ Reliable
- ▶ Available



Level of Commitment

- ▶ For at least 6 to 12 months after the club is chartered

Benefits

- ▶ Credit towards ALS recognition
- ▶ Enrichment of knowledge
- ▶ Varied exposure



Official Duties (1)

- ▶ Build rapport with the club.
- ▶ Ensure the club is strong and functional.
- ▶ Familiarize the club with the TI website. (www.toastmasters.org)



Official Duties (2)

- ▶ Conduct *The Successful Club Series (SCS)* program.
- ▶ Make certain that club officers attend district-sponsored training.
- ▶ Conduct *SCS Series* program – How to Be a Distinguished Club.



Official Duties (3)

- ▶ Help club members build positive habits.
- ▶ Create a quality club.
- ▶ Foster a culture of membership-building within the club.

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The Club Success Plan (1)

- ▶ Helps the club determine how it is going to meet 10 critical goals
- ▶ Allows the club to establish additional goals of its own.
- ▶ Outlines strategies for achieving goals.



The Club Success Plan (2)

- ▶ Identifies resources the club may use
- ▶ Has space to write in assignments, develop a timetable, and track accomplishments.
- ▶ Officers should meet after being elected to study and use the Club Success Plan



The Club Success Plan (3)

- ▶ Officers should ... Club Success Plan
 - to set goals for their term of office
 - to assign responsibilities to specific individuals
 - to form committees to help them accomplish goals
 - to review the goals and timetables



The Club Success Plan (4)

- ▶ Officers should ... Club Success Plan
 - to note the club's accomplishments at year-end for future incoming officers
- ▶ During the area governor's two visits they will review the club's plan, discuss the club's progress in it, and offer advice or assistance if necessary.
